Health and Local Food for Families receives no core funds from the Government. We have to raise all our funds through fundraising from the public and grant making trusts and other organisations to fund the sessions we run.

As a small, relatively new Charity, raising funds can be very difficult. We should therefore be most grateful if you would consider donating to Health and Local Food for Families (HALFF). If you are a UK tax payer, you can Gift Aid your donation by completing the form below.

Using Gift Aid means that for every pound you give, HALFF will receive an extra 28 pence from the Inland Revenue, helping your donation go further.

This means that £10 can be turned into £12.80 just so long as donations are made through Gift Aid. Imagine what a difference that could make, and it doesn't cost you a thing.
